

Holders who have not received a hard copy form may not have received it yet via Australia Post or if they have not received the email, we suggest they check their junk/spam folders, if shareholders cannot locate the proxy form, they can call the information line and request one or go to the voting site and as long as they have their SRN/HIN & Postcode they will be able to vote online. They can also call up to request to amend their communication preferences for future mailings.

The NoM on the ASX has the “sample” proxy form ([ASX link](#)) however, we would never suggest holders use that as it doesn’t have their specific information on it. They should only use the Proxy forms that have their personalised information on it or go to the Investor Vote website and vote online, the documents available to view on Investor Vote are the NoM and AR, as the actual site itself is the voting form, once the holder logs in they can see the online version of the voting form and lodge their votes.

- If a holder wants a replacement hard copy of the Proxy form or replacement email sent, they can contact – 1300 850 505, noting this request needs to be made by the shareholder.
- If the holder wants to vote online and they can’t locate the email broadcast we sent, they can log into the Investor Vote site - [Login - InvestorVote, Computershare Limited](#) – enter BITs control number – 138331 – they will then be prompted to enter their SRN/HIN & Postcode which will allow them to see the online version of the voting form and lodge their votes online.
